

Wroughton Neighbourhood Plan

Decision Statement published pursuant to the Localism Act 2011 Schedule 38A (9) and Regulations 19 and 20 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

At a full Council on 14th July 2016, Swindon Borough Council formally decided to make (adopt) the Wroughton Neighbourhood Plan under Section 38A (4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) . This means the Wroughton Neighbourhood Plan has now been brought into legal force, forming part of the statutory development plan for Swindon Borough. Consequently the plan will be used to determine planning applications in Wroughton Parish.

Reasons for Decision

The Wroughton Neighbourhood Plan meets the basic conditions and is compliant with the legal and procedural requirements. Paragraph 38A (4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) requires the Council to make the Neighbourhood Plan if more than half of those voting in the referendum upon the Plan have voted in favour of the Plan being used to inform planning applications in the area. The Plan was endorsed by more than the required threshold in the referendum of 9th June 2016.
