

Hi Emma,

I have had a look at the tree quotes for the Horse Chestnut as you were not sure they were like for like? I have had a look and the description of the tree work that needs undertaking it's pretty much the same for all three quotes and matches the suggestion from the borough which is the following:

T1, Horse Chestnut; located to the northwest of the church hall: Lift crown to a height of approximately 3m above ground level. Reduce those branches, on the eastern side of the canopy, that overhang the car park back to within 1m of the boundary. All pruning cuts must be made at branch junctions, leaving sufficient live growth to maintain or enhance crown form

The only difference is that Danny Mason has not said that he would clear/dispose the chippings.

I think it's important to mention that we have used all three tree surgeons before (over the past 3 years), Danny Mason for the tree at Thorney Park – however I think there are other jobs? Bawden for the large conifer trees at the Weir and DW tree services for work to some trees in Willow brook gardens (crown thinning of three asters at Willow brook gardens and some emergency work at Maunsell Way)
