Use of hosepipe at Weir Field, Wroughton – Running from Garage location to Cricket Square

Trip Hazard – when using the hosepipe that runs from the Weirfield garage to the cricket square.	Members of the public, whilst walking on the footpath in front of the garage. Members of the public who may have mobility difficulties, walk with aids, or use a wheelchair/mobility scooter, and members of the public who may have reduced vision. Members of the public including vulnerable adults and children who may be using the public open space, and playing on the grass.	When the hosepipe is in use, 2x trip hazard ‘A-signs’ will be placed on the footpath, one 4m either side of the hose. 4 further signs to be placed on the hose on the field, equally spaced along its length. A first aid kit is kept in the pavilion kitchen. Also, a key to the main field gate kept in a break box on the left when entering the pavilion in case of emergencies. All cricket club members will be emailed a copy of this document.	At least two people will be in immediate attendance when the hose is in use. They are to verbally warn people, especially children and older people of the hazard. A copy of this risk assessment will be placed inside the garage door alongside a use log for the hose detailing the dates the hose is used and the start / finish time for water usage. The garage must be supervised at all times when the hose is in use and when the doors are open to ensure that any chemicals or hazardous substances are locked away in accordance with COSHH. The hose must never be left unattended when in use.	Whoever is using the hose.	Every time the hose is in use and/or the garage doors are open.	N/A
