M4 J16 to J15 eastbound Weekend works – 8 to 11 March 2024

National Highways operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A-roads.

This postcard is to let you know we'll be carrying out essential repairs to the M4 carriageway. To do the work safely we'll need to close the hard shoulder and lane 1 of the M4 eastbound between junctions 16 and 15, from Friday 8 March at 7pm to Monday 11 March at 6am. We anticipate this may cause delays during peak traffic times and would advise motorists to find an alternative route if possible.

Please accept our apologies in advance for any inconvenience which may be caused. We'll make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to a minimum.
