Subject: Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report 2023 - 2024

Good afternoon,

I have now published my Annual Report which I hope you will find informative, as well as providing an overall summary of the work undertaken by myself and my team during this year.

Since my last report I have been re-elected to the role of Police and Crime Commissioner and we have also had a change of government. However, all that has been achieved during the 2023/4 year across all areas - and before both elections took place - is no less significant due to the shortened nature of my first PCC term as a result of the impact of the pandemic.

The report highlights a 16.6% drop in anti-social behaviour incidents in 2023/2024 compared to 2022/2023, as well as a 13.4% reduction in domestic abuse-related crimes, observed across all Neighbourhood Policing Team areas in the same time frame. It also includes a general progress update and summary of continued engagements, media coverage, events and, importantly, finances for my office and the Chief Constable's spending.

My focus has been – and which will now continue through the next four years – to support Wiltshire Police as it continues its improvement journey and delivering upon my mission of Making Wiltshire Safer.
