This Working Party has been set up to monitor the design, installation, use, maintenance and management of the new cricket pitch site, including the pavilion, car park and cricket pitch itself, all to be provided by Hills (the developer) or their successor, together with any other matter relating to the development site.

Membership

Membership shall include Councillors Hewer, Keetch and ?????, and a representative from Wroughton Wranglers Cricket Club. Any additional members of the Hills Working Party may be invited at the discretion of the CA&OS Committee as and when the Committee requires or wishes to have input from stakeholders or other interested parties. The Committee shall determine whether those stakeholders or other interested parties remain as working party members or are invited to give specific input for a temporary duration only.

Terms of Reference

1. To make recommendations to Hills and/ or any future management organisation on the design, installation, use, maintenance and management of the pavilion, cricket pitch site and car park.
2. To request and consider the anticipated income and running costs of the pavilion, cricket pitch site and car park.
3. To consider any other matters concerning the pavilion, cricket pitch site and car park, including additional uses for other sports.
4. To consider any matter related to the development site as a whole, including any expansion of the site.
