Ellendune Hall Trust – Section 105 order

Enclosed is the section 105 order to authorise the conflicts of interest so that the trustees can make a decision regarding the proposed transfer of assets from Ellendune Hall Trust ('transferring charity') to The Ellendune Community Centre ('receiving charity').

Advice in relation to Permanent Endowment and Special Trust property

The order authorises the trustees of your charity to decide to accept the transfer of the transferring charity's trusteeship of its permanent endowment and special trusts. Your charity will hold any permanent endowment and special trusts transferred to it as trustee on the separate trusts that govern such property.

So that your charity is able to comply with its duties as trustee of this property, you must be clear what property your charity will hold on trust and what the terms of those trusts are.

You should require the transferring charity's trustees to provide a list of the property it holds on trust as permanent endowment or special trust property, together with a copy of the governing document or other information that sets out the trusts that apply to such property.

Permanent endowment can be a special trust, but it is not always a special trust.

If the trustee is in any doubt of the procedure to formally transfer the charity's property to the receiving charity, they should seek professional advice.
