

**ORDER OF
THE CHARITY COMMISSION FOR ENGLAND AND WALES**

To authorise under section 105 of the Charities Act 2011 the conflict of interest so that the trustees can make a decision regarding the proposed transfer of assets

dated the

02 July 2025

for the charities known as

ELLENDUNE HALL TRUST (305601)

and

THE ELLENDUNE COMMUNITY CENTRE CIO (1198813)

ORDER

In this order:

“the transferring charity” means Ellendune Hall Trust (305601)

“the receiving charity” means The Ellendune Community Centre CIO (1198813)

“the assets” means the assets of the transferring charity that are not permanent endowment

“trustees” means charity trustees as defined in section 177 of the Charities Act 2011

“permanent endowment” is any property of the transferring charity that is subject to a restriction on being expended which distinguishes between income and capital

2. Being satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the transferring charity, the Commission authorises the conflict of interest so that the trustees of the transferring charity can decide to:

(a) transfer the assets of the transferring charity to the receiving charity; and

(b) appoint the receiving charity as trustee of any permanent endowment.

3. Being satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the receiving charity, the Commission authorises the conflict of interest so that its trustees can decide to:

(a) receive the assets of the transferring charity; and

(b) accept the appointment of the receiving charity as trustee of any permanent endowment.
