Also further to my previous email, the deed does actually specify the use of this specific contribution and a later contribution due at 3000 dwellings for use within **Wroughton**, however both contributions would still need to be bid for through the formal process I previously described as the Council could allocate and apply the funding directly to a project instead of passing it to the Parish if it chooses to do so.

Regeneration Community and Social Facility Contribution

4.5 to pay to the Council the Regeneration and Social Facility Contribution in the following instalments:

- (a) £280,142 prior to the Occupation of 1600 Dwellings to be used for the purposes specified in this Deed in Wroughton.
- (b) £280,142 prior to the Occupation of 2300 Dwellings to be used for the purposes specified in this Deed in Swindon Old Town.
- (c) £280,141 prior to the Occupation of 3000 Dwellings to be used for the purposes specified in this Deed in Wroughton.
