Subject: Public consultation on the update of the Swindon Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan

Dear Clerk,

Swindon Borough Council have prepared a draft update of its Local Cycling and Walking infrastructure Plan (LCWIP). We are now seeking your views on the scheme proposals identified to improve the network for cyclists and walkers across the borough over the next ten years.

LCWIPs represent the long-term strategic approach being promoted by the government to determine the walking and cycling infrastructure which is required across a defined area. This plan follows the guidance issued by the Department for Transport, which has to date generated a programme of twenty-five recommended scheme proposals.

The proposals cover a combination of upgrades to the existing network following on from the recent improvements in Swindon town centre, enhancing connectivity into the growth areas of the borough and addressing missing links between the core Swindon urban area the surrounding settlements. This package of measures would be used as a basis for future funding bids for grants from central government. Early engagement has been held with the Swindon Cycle Campaign and the local Ramblers group for initial viewpoints. Members of the public and wider stakeholders are now invited to view and comment on the draft Swindon LCWIP, its objectives, the prioritisation process to determine the improvements, the scheme proposals identified and put forward any further enhancements for consideration.
