



Free Flood Prevention for Parish residents

The Parish Council has just received an order of 50 aquasacs which we are providing free of charge to residents who are at risk of house flooding. Aquasacs are the modern equivalent of sandbags, but are stored flat and expanded when needed.

Aquasacs

- Inflate in 3-5 minutes
- Weigh 13kg when inflated (440g when flat)
- Are reusable
- 54 cms long and 10 cms high
- 5 year shelf life when in their sealed packs
- Non toxic
- Effective for floods up to 2 foot high
- Dry out in 6-8 weeks and can be re-inflated providing there is no contamination

To claim your aquasacs

- You must live in the Parish.
- Your address must be provided and not be in a location where the risk of flooding is clearly unlikely to occur.
- Email your address and requested number of bags to clerk@chiseldon-pc.gov.uk We will limit the quantity supplied per house to 8 which should be enough to place in front of 2 doors, 2 bags high. We can consider further requests once we establish the need.
- We will keep your name, address and email on a password protected file as a record of who has received the aquasacs.
- The bags are yours to keep. You should dry them out and store them as the manufacturer states so you can use them again.
- We will deliver within the parish when we are able to, so please provide details of when someone will be home, or a dry place we can place them for safekeeping.
- We will not provide aquasacs to prevent flooding of sheds, greenhouses or other outbuildings.
- The Parish Council hold no responsibility for aquasacs used, which do not prevent flooding as the manufacturer claims. You use the aquasacs completely at your own risk, to supplement any other flood measures you may wish to take.
