CIL Funds Spending Project Report

The parish council must provide full details of all projects funded by Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) contributions over the past three years to demonstrate transparency and accountability in how these public funds have been used. Reporting ensures that spending aligns with the statutory requirements of supporting local infrastructure and community improvements. It also allows residents and oversight bodies to see the benefits delivered and to confirm that CIL money has been managed responsibly and effectively.

This report highlights projects which have already been completed by using parish council CIL funds:

This means that while work is underway, the full expenditure cannot yet be reported. Final figures will be provided once the projects are completed and all invoices have been received.
