Agenda Item 8 – Perrys Lane Bus Shelter Progress Update

Purpose of the Report

Members are required to:

- **NOTE** the report and **AGREE** the recommendation.

Background

The bus stop on Perrys Lane, opposite The Orchards and adjacent to the small strip of grass, is regularly used by residents. The stop currently has no shelter, which leaves users exposed to the elements.

The parish council has previously agreed in principle to consider the use of Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funds for the purchase and installation of a new bus shelter at this location in order to make bus passengers more comfortable. (Min ref CAOS/095)

Initial discussions have indicated that the site appears suitable for a bus shelter, however formal assessments and approvals will be required before progressing. As the land is owned by Swindon Borough Council, their consent and relevant highways approvals will form a key part of the process.

Delivery Option – Bauer Media (September '26 Update)

Through initial discussions with Swindon Borough Council, it was suggested that the parish council contact Bauer Media, who may be open to working with the parish to put a bus shelter in place.

Discussions with Bauer have proceeded slowly over the summer. In late July, however, Bauer offered the parish council the following arrangements:

- A quote for £24,119 (Excl VAT) for a UK Landmark II Argyle Glass Roof Bus Shelter
- The quote to include the supply and installation of the shelter and the hardstand for the shelter to sit on
- The maintenance responsibilities and costs to be picked up by WWPC
- A wait time of 25-28 weeks before installation

The design of the proposed shelter is here:

Alternative Options

If the arrangements offered by Bauer Media are deemed unsuitable to the committee, the parish council could instead choose to purchase and install a bus shelter itself, for which the parish has previously used GW Shelter Solutions.

Some possible options from GW Shelter Solutions are attached at **Appendix B**, **Appendix C** and **Appendix D**.

Recommendations

- To **AGREE** to proceed with either Bauer Media or through the parish council sourcing its own shelter via GW Shelter Solutions.

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
